Subject: In Aftermath of Democratic and Republican National Conventions, Voters Trust Biden Over Trump on Issue of Healthcare Coronavirus, and Reject Efforts to Overturn the ACA

Date: September 3, 2020

A new Public Policy Polling survey, fielded right after both political conventions, finds that voters trust Joe Biden more than Donald Trump on all important health care issues, including safeguarding Medicare, protecting people with pre-existing conditions, and holding drug and insurance companies accountable. Voters also trust Vice President Biden more than President Trump on the coronavirus pandemic, including on safely reopening schools, rebuilding the economy, and developing an effective vaccine.

President Trump's lawsuit to strike down the ACA in the middle of a pandemic is also rejected by voters, by a 22 point margin. Just 31% of voters nationwide think the law should be struck down by the courts, while a majority (53%) overall disagree with striking down the ACA. Voters by a 12 point margin, 52 to 40, say they trust Democrats in congress more on health care than Republican in Congress.

- 53% trust Joe Biden to protect Medicare, while just 40% trust President Trump.
- 52% trust Biden to protect healthcare for people with preexisting conditions, while just 41% say they trust Trump.
- 51% trust Biden to have a plan to prevent future pandemics, compared to just 41% who say they trust Trump more.
- 51% trust Biden to keep Americans safe during the coronavirus pandemic, while only 41% trust Trump.
- 51% trust Biden to lead the government-wide effort to develop and approve an effective coronavirus vaccine, while only 42% trust Trump more.
- 50% trust Biden more to make healthcare affordable, while just 41% trust Trump.
- 50% trust Biden more to have a plan to safely reopen schools, compared to just 40% who say they trust Trump more.





Public Policy Polling surveyed 885 national voters from August 28-29, 2020. The margin of error is +/-3.3%. 50% of interviews for the survey were conducted by telephone and 50% by text message.
